Award for Excellence in Teaching in Civil Engineering — 2027

## Conditions of application & how to apply

Please read the eligibility conditions and prepare the required documents before submitting.

### Who can apply

- Individual lecturers or teaching teams in civil engineering.
- The candidate must belong to an institution that is a **fee-paying member** of the EUCEET Association.
- Each EUCEET member institution may put forward **one official nomination**.
- No nationality requirement — eligibility is defined by the candidate's institution being a member in good standing.

### What to submit

- **Application form** (EUCEET template), duly completed.
- **Description of the teaching practice** or initiative (objectives, method, context).
- **Evidence of impact** (data, outcomes, student feedback, results).
- **CV of the applicant** or short profile of the teaching team.
- **Optional:** student or peer testimonials, links, publications or media.

### How candidates are assessed

Applications are evaluated by an independent jury against four criteria — **Impact, Innovation, Transferability** and **European value** — using a shared scoring grid. A clear conflict-of-interest rule applies to all jury members.

### The jury (2027)

A five-member jury appointed by the EUCEET Administrative Council, balanced across countries, chaired by the EUCEET Secretary General and including the President, a previous jury member, the 2025 Award winner and a further Council member.
